2025 PCVMA DUES

Dear Colleagues,

2024, was an excellent year for the PCVMA membership. Your dues made available The Florida Laws and Rules and Pharmacy Dispensing, six CE sponsored dinners at Bascom's Chop House, the PCVMA Baseball Game Outing, monthly newsletters and classifieds. In addition, the PCVMA keeps everyone up to date on CE, political/legislative issues and business/financial issues and keeps your attendance records on file for auditing. We also held the first CE meeting for CVTs and Technicians and two more planned for 2025.

Dues also help support the Foundation by sponsoring the Pet Loss Support Program for grieving clients with phone counseling and monthly group sessions, provides scholarships for veterinary technician students at SPC and the Edna Klauser Pet Professor Program in the kindergarten and elementary schools. The Bowser and Catsino Ball 2024, had 300 in attendance including veterinarians, hospitals, staff, families and industry partners. \$6,500.00 was donated to SPC students for scholarships and hospital staff for hurricane relief.

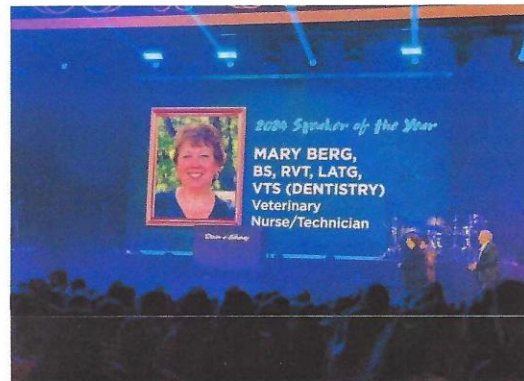
SPC COLLEGE OF VETERINARY TECHNOLOGY

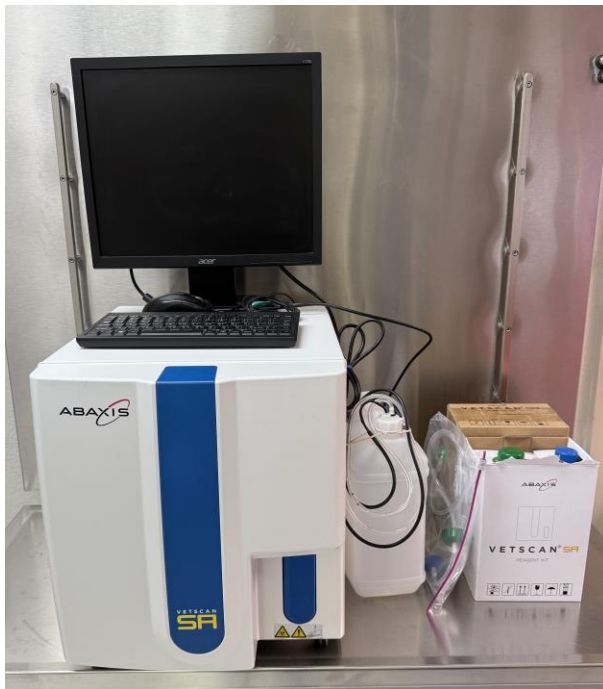
