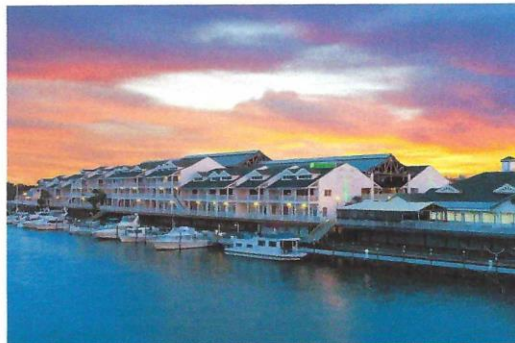

SPC SCHOOL OF VETERINARY TECHNOLOGY

St Petersburg College is on our summer session which is busy for both faculty and student as the semester is only 10 weeks long

Trish Gorham, Annette Poirier, Ariel Gilpin and Dr Megan Branham traveled in May to Zimbabwe for another service-learning opportunity. This program focuses on primary wildlife management and conservation initiatives in 3 regions of Zimbabwe, namely Antelope Park (Gweru), Hwange National Park, and Victoria Falls. While there we worked with Veterinarians for Animal Welfare Zimbabwe (VAWZ) and participated in 2 spay/neuter clinics where we performed at least 30 procedures and vaccinated over 100 dogs for rabies which is endemic in that region. We were able to participate in procedures with Sabal Antelope as well as Lions. We worked in a village near Victoria Fall to secure the bomas for their cattle as they currently have 3 prides of lions living outside the village.

We are currently enrolling for fall classes and expect to have a large freshman class and anticipate graduating one of the largest classes since Covid.

SPCA TAMPA BAY

This year has brought some unique challenges to our sheltering community. Not only here in Pinellas County, or even the Tampa Bay region, but all across the nation, shelters are seeing higher numbers of owner surrendered animals and a slowing in adoption rates, with dogs being most profoundly impacted. What does this mean? Well, it means that the shelters are experiencing higher numbers of animals, who are staying longer and needing more care. Several shelters in our area are at or nearly at capacity. While there are many theories as to why this is happening, increased cost of living factors predominantly in most researchers' minds. If you are interested in more information, University of Florida's own Shelter Medicine program has been sharing articles and information on this trend.

In order to help alleviate some of the need, I am asking that you please encourage people who are looking for a shelter pet to adopt to reach out to their local shelter this summer, and if they cannot adopt, consider fostering. If fostering is not your cup of tea, then consider volunteering or donating directly to your local shelter.

Here at SPCA Tampa Bay we are currently decreasing adoption fees for the summer, as well as implementing several other ideas to help get our shelter pets into homes. Attached is a flyer that you can print and share. Thank you in advance for helping in whatever way you can.

Pet Surrender Prevention Strategies

With shelters and rescues at or exceeding capacity nationwide, it's more important now than ever to shift resources toward the prevention of owner surrenders.

Here are a few strategies we have implemented at the shelter:

1. Increased access to free pet food

Free pet food is available in our lobby and operates on donations from our pet store partners, community members, and businesses. Last year, we gave out nearly 15,000 lbs. of food! When we have excess, we also supply pet food to three food banks: Dunedin Cares, United Methodist Church in Pinellas Park, and Daystar in St. Petersburg. Friends of Strays donates food to the public through the St. Petersburg Free Clinic and SPCA Tampa Bay opens their food bank to the public on Tuesdays from 2-4 p.m.

2. Vouchers to assist financially challenged Pinellas County residents with free Spay/Neuter and/or preventative care.

If a family is receiving government assistance, they can visit the shelter to pick up a voucher. We partnered with 6 veterinary clinics to provide these services. Funding is limited and provided through our donation-based Animal Welfare Trust Fund.

*At this time, our voucher funding has been depleted, with funding generally being replenished at the beginning of the fiscal year, October 1st.

3. Rehoming Assistance: Home to Home Network

Currently, our non-profit rescue partners, Friends of Strays & Humane Society of Pinellas offer those wishing to rehome their pets the option to post them on their website with a photo and bio. Home to Home helps keep pets out of shelters through direct home placement.

We also have an extensive list of breed-specific rescues for pet owners to contact for additional assistance.

While these strategies are helping, we are still confronted daily with families struggling to find affordable, pet-friendly housing, free of breed discrimination in Pinellas County. We continue to work alongside groups, like St. Pete PAWS and My Pit Bull is Family to address these challenges and map out solutions. Both groups have searchable pet inclusive rental databases on their websites, too!

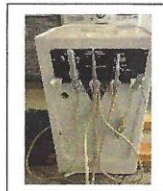
