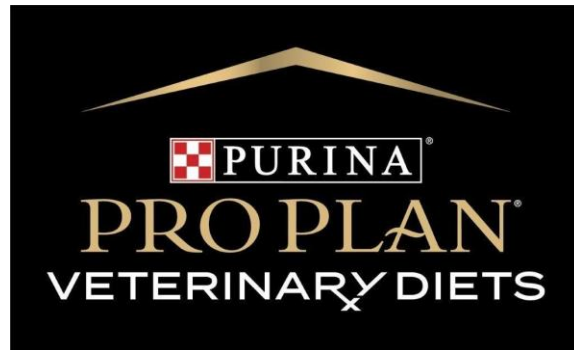

## THE 28<sup>TH</sup> ANNUAL COMMISSIONER JOHN MORRONI LAW ENFORCEMENT AND FIRST RESPONDER APPRECIATION AND LEGACY DINNER

For the past fifteen years, the PCVMA has sponsored a table and presented the “Jeffery Yaslowitz Outstanding K9 Team of the Year Award” for Pinellas County. Corporal Matt Aitken of the Pinellas County Sheriff’s Office and K9 “Taco” won this year’s award. Cpl. Aitken and Taco were caught in an ambush on the evening of March 12, 2023. The suspect shot Cpl. Aitken three times as he was able to release Taco. Taco took down the suspect as Sergeant Jacob Viano, Pinellas County Sheriff’s Office Deputy of the Year 2023, was arriving on scene. Fortunately after missing three rounds fired by the suspect, Sgt. Viano was able to fatally wound the suspect and ultimately saving the lives of Cpl. Aitken, himself and Taco. Taco is now retired after a great career with the Sheriff’s Office K9 unit. Cpl. Aitken is currently assigned to the Training Division. **Congratulations!**

Dr. Howell made the presentation for the PCVMA award. Over 400 people attended the annual event recognizing our great Law Enforcement and Responder Teams in Pinellas.

## PINELLAS COUNTY ANIMAL SERVICES

Greeting from the staff and volunteers at Pinellas County Animal Services. Spring has been a busy time for Animal Services. Our renovation of the kennel buildings is progressing on schedule. Phase 1 is projected to be completed by end of April and we will move our shelter pets into the 2 newly re-modeled buildings so that phase 2 can begin on the remaining buildings. Upon completion all the buildings will be hardened for up to a Category 4 storm, new paint, new floor, new kennels, new roof and a sprinkler system. Upon completion of phase 2 air conditioning will also be installed and operational for all 4 of our buildings. This renovation is expected to extend the life of our campus by another 20 to 25 years.

Pinellas County is working on the FY25 budget to begin October 1<sup>st</sup>, 2024. County pet licensing fees will be increasing for FY25. The new fees will be:

1 year license for dog and cat will be \$22.

3 year license for dog and cat will be \$44.

The rebate percentage for license resellers remains unchanged. Staff will be communicating directly with license resellers on these fee changes prior to the October 1<sup>st</sup>, 2024 effective date.

PCAS is participating in the American Legion Standdown at Bay Pines this year providing vaccines and microchips for veterans. The North Shore Animal League will be at Pinellas County Animal Services April 5<sup>th</sup> and 6<sup>th</sup> for their annual Tour for Life Adoption Event.

Pet Walk has expanded this year and is set for two Pinellas County locations, North Straub Park in St. Petersburg and a new second location in Largo at Largo Central Park! SPCA Tampa Bay is asking for the community’s help by signing up to become a walker at **PetWalk.org** and forming a Pet Walk team to help make a difference in the lives of homeless pets and wildlife in SPCA Tampa Bay’s care. It is free to register for Pet Walk and all walkers who raise \$50 or more will receive an exclusive walker t-shirt, swag bag, and pet bandanna! In addition to the walk itself, both locations will feature a pet costume contest with prizes, awards and recognition for top fundraisers and teams, pet products from vendors, local food trucks, and two walk courses of varying lengths depending on the comfort level of you and your pet.

The community’s support of Pet Walk helps SPCA Tampa Bay continue to provide a variety of services to Pinellas County residents, including an animal adoption program, wildlife rehabilitation program, and multiple pet food banks. 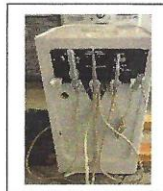
