Phase 1 of our shelter renovation project is almost complete. 2 of our dog housing buildings will be completed and ready for use in May, the buildings have been hardened for up to a Category 4 Hurricane, new dog kennels, new lighting, roofing, paint, and a fire sprinkler system. Phase 2 of the project to renovate the remaining dog housing building and the cat housing building will begin in June.

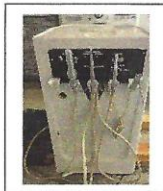

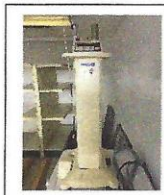
